

# **Invitation** European Field Archery Championships 2005 Tahkuranna, Estonia August 1.-6. 2005

## <u>The Field Archery Association of Estonia would like to invite all registred archers of IFAA</u> <u>membership nations from Europe to participate in the European Field Archery Championships</u> <u>held in Estonia in 2005</u>

### Time and format

EFAC 2005 is a 5-day event which is due to take place from the 1st till the 6th of August in 2005. All five days are to be shot into official IFAA target faces, there are going to be 2x Field, 2x Hunter and 1x Animal Round, all at marked distances. The winner in each division is the person who gets the biggest score of all five days. Competition will be held in official IFAA divisions plus also in **Cubs** Longbow and Primitive bow – these will be in program as guest divisions. Primitive archers are invited to compete for "Nordic Champion" titles.

### The Venue

The 2005 European Field Archery Championships will be held in Estonia in Jõulumäe Health and Sports Centre which is situated in South-Western Estonia in the wondeful county of Pärnu in Tahkuranna Parish. The landscape in Tahkuranna is fairly hilly but yet not at all rocky. The typical surrounding are pine forests with mossy ground. The centre itself offers various after-competition activities as well as entertainment in the evenings. Distances to bigger cities and airports – Tallinn – capital of Estonia -150 km, Riga – capital of Latvia - 150 km, Pärnu – "summer capital" of Estonia and truly a wonderful town – 25 km

### **Registration**
